1. Ordinance Amendment

“Amending Chapter 33: Human Resources of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester by amending language under §33.080 Military Service.”

Alderman T. Sapienza moved that the Ordinance Amendment ought to pass and be referred to the Committee on Accounts, Enrollment and Revenue Administration.

Alderman E. Sapienza duly seconded the motion.

Alderman T. Sapienza asked when we pay servicemen who go for training, do we pay them their full day's wage minus what the federal government pays them or the military pays them.

Kathleen Ferguson, HR Director, answered I believe it is the difference but I will double-check on that for you. I will let you know tomorrow. Is that okay?

Alderman T. Sapienza stated yes. I won't hold this up but I would like to know the answer to that.

Ms. Ferguson replied it does say here that it is 20 days of paid military leave and it doesn't say with the deduction of whatever they get paid so my thought is, because it is not in the ordinance, that it is not but I can double-check.

Alderman T. Sapienza responded yes please check.
