1. The Traffic Division has submitted an agenda which needs to be addressed:

Communication from Kristen Clarke, Traffic Engineer, regarding the status of the city's request to the NHDOT to study the possibility of adding a crosswalk on NH Route 28 Bypass in the vicinity of the Rockingham Rail Trail and recommending that the estimated cost of \$50,000 to \$100,000 be included in DPW's CIP request for next year.

3. Special events update from the Police Department, if available.

Allen Aldenberg, Police Chief, stated on 11/5 there will be the Cross-Country Meet of Champions at Derryfield Park, on 11/11 we have the Veteran's Parade on Elm Street, on 11/13 is the CMC Marathon and there will be a lot of road closures and detours and detail officers. On 11/24 we have the Fisher Cats 5K. That course is still to be determined due to the rail trail closure. On 12/3 we have the Santa Shuffle and Holiday Parade on Elm Street.
