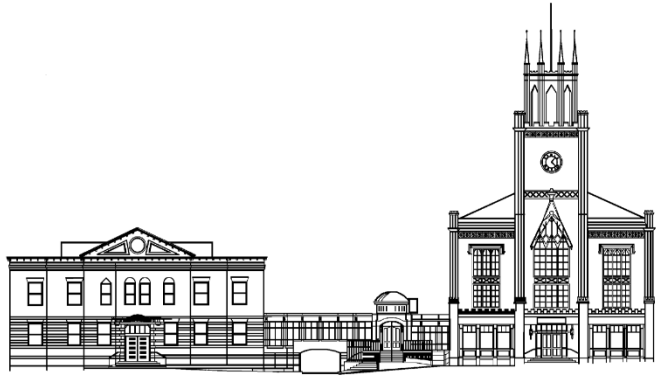

Ordinance Changes Associated with the BMA Approval of Change in Traffic Pattern on Reservoir Ave on 5/31/24:

ONE-WAY

On Reservoir Avenue westbound, from Circular Drive to a point 190 feet east of Belmont Street

NO PARKING- ACTIVE LOADING AND UNLOADING ONLY 7:30-8:30 AM, 2:00-3:00 PM

On Reservoir Avenue, north side, from a point 370 feet east of Belmont Street to a point 470 feet further east

On Reservoir Avenue, north side, from a point 1,010 feet east of Belmont Street to a point 315 feet further east

NO PARKING ANYTIME

On Reservoir Avenue, north side, from a point 190 feet east of Belmont Street to a point 180 feet further east

On Reservoir Avenue, north side, from a point 840 feet east of Belmont Street to a point 170 feet further east

On Reservoir Avenue, south side, from a point 190 feet east of Belmont Street to a point 285 feet further east

RESCIND NO PARKING ANYTIME

On Reservoir Avenue, north side, from the east driveway of Hillside School to Oak Hill Avenue (ORD 7327)

On Reservoir Avenue, north side, from Hillside School to a point 40 feet west of the east driveway of Hillside School (ORD 3558)

RESCIND NO PARKING HANDICAP PARKING ONLY

On Reservoir Avenue, north side, from the east driveway of Hillside School to a point 40 feet westerly (ORD 7326)
