Immediately Following Bills on Second Reading

Chairman Levasseur called the meeting to order.

1. Communication from Cory Dubois, Fuss & O'Neil, requesting approval of an agreement to allow encroachment into the city's right-of-way at 351 Chestnut Street.

*On motion of **Alderman Goonan**, duly seconded by **Alderman Long**, it was voted to approve.*

2. Communication from the family of Inspector William Moher, a police officer who died in the line of duty on July 3, 1921, requesting that the city find a fitting way to honor his memory.
(Note: City staff from Planning, Police and DPW have been asked to bring forward recommendations.)

Alderman O'Neil stated I know the departments are working on this and have come up with some pretty good ideas that need to be vetted a little more. I would ask that you table it at this time until there is a formal recommendation from the departments.

 - Remove all the wooden posts and signs in the Gill/JFK area;
 - Install a large sign on the exterior of Gill Stadium, of a style in harmony with this historic facility, to include the names of all contributors and a way-finding map to the trees they sponsored; and
 - Make available to family members the existing name plate, should they so desire it.*(Note: Tabled on 2/20/24 pending further information from the department.)*

*On motion of **Alderman Long**, duly seconded by **Alderman Goonan**, it was voted to remove this item from the table.*

Alderman Long moved to receive and file. **Alderman Goonan** duly seconded the motion. Chairman Levasseur called for a vote. The motion carried with Alderman Vincent being duly recorded in opposition.
