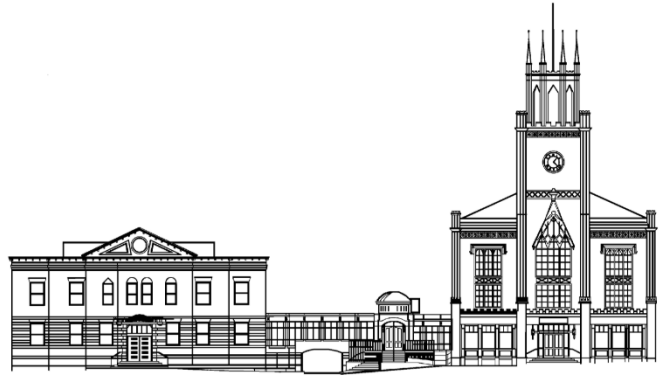




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## **SPECIAL MEETING BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN PUBLIC HEARING - TIF DISTRICT**

### **AGENDA**

The Mayor calls the meeting to order.

The Mayor calls for the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. The Mayor advises that the purpose of the special meeting is to hear those wishing to speak on the creation of a tax increment financing district that would occupy approximately 415 acres, with approximate boundaries of Bridge Street/Lake Avenue, Beech Street, Queen City Avenue, and the Merrimack River, for the purposes of financing the construction of a bridge, rail trail, intersection improvements, and pedestrian improvements within the area; that anyone wishing to speak must first step to the nearest microphone when recognized and give his/her name and address in a clear, loud voice for the record; that each person will be given only one opportunity to speak; that each person will be limited to three minutes to speak; and any questions must be directed to the Chair.
