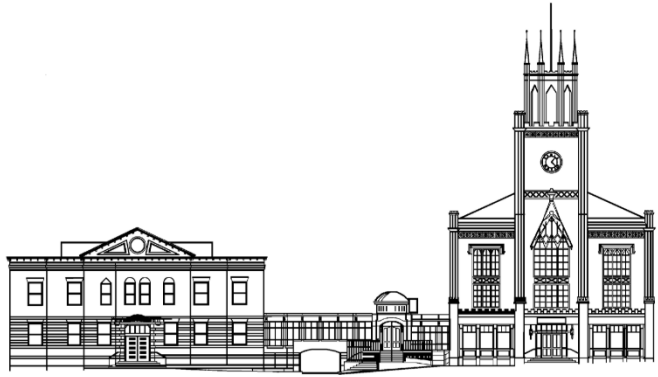

AN ORDINANCE

“Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester by amending §32.029 Funding and Resource Management pertaining to the Art Commission by increasing spending authorization without board approval to \$1,000 per project.”

- I. Amend the Code of Ordinances by inserting new language as bolded (**bold**) and deleting existing language as stricken (-----). Portions of the following sections that remain unchanged appear in regular type.

§ 32.029 FUNDING AND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT.

(A) Absent specific conditions to the contrary, all gifts of money intended to further the Commission’s purpose and accepted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen shall be deposited in a dedicated, non-lapsing Arts Fund to be used by the Commission, to be used for supporting local arts projects, community arts programs, and artist development initiatives.

(B) The Commission shall have the authority to seek additional funding through grants, partnerships, and fundraising activities.

(C) The city finance officer, pursuant to R.S.A. 41:29 shall have custody of all monies in the Arts fund. The Commission shall have the authority to utilize funds from the Arts Fund without Board of Mayor and Aldermen approval up to ~~\$250.00~~ **\$1,000** with a unanimous vote in favor by the Commission members.

(D) Singular or cumulative expenditures for a single project exceeding ~~\$250.00~~ **\$1,000** shall be subject to approval from the Board of Mayor and Aldermen upon recommendation of the Committee on Accounts, Enrollment and Revenue Administration.

- II. This ordinance shall take effect on upon passage.

AN ORDINANCE

“Amending Section 33.081 Sick Leave (D) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester to change the terms of sick leave use.”

I. Amend the Code of Ordinances by deleting language stricken (---) and inserting new language as bolded (**bold**). Language not struck through or bolded remains unchanged.

§33.081 SICK LEAVE.

(D) Any employee eligible for sick leave with pay may use such sick leave, upon approval of their department or office head, for absence due to ~~his or her~~ **their** own illness, injury; the illness or injury of the employee's spouse, child, or parent; or the illness or injury of a blood relative or ward residing in the same household; or for the exposure to contagious disease. An employee on sick leave shall inform their immediate supervisor of the fact and the reason therefor as soon as possible. Failure to do so within a reasonable time may be cause for denial of pay for the period of absence. ~~In the case of a pandemic, a doctor's certificate may not be required for a period or periods of more than three work days.~~ **An employee experiencing a period of incapacity and or serious medical condition due to their own illness, injury; the illness or injury of the employee's spouse, child, or parent; or the illness or injury of a blood relative or ward residing in the same household; requiring an absence of more than three (3) calendar days from work is required to apply for the Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA). In the case of a pandemic, a doctor's certificate may not be required for a period or periods of more than three work days.**
